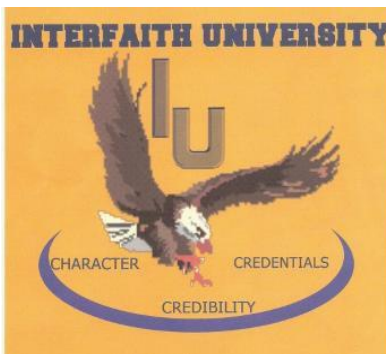
### **Our Vision**

## Frequently Asked Questions

### 1. What is Interfaith University?

Interfaith University (I.U.) is an interdenominational, non-denominational, Christian college made up of several interlocking schools that focus on various aspects of Christianity and life.

### 2. What is Interfaith Bible Training School?

Similar to our *School of Timothy Advanced Ministry Training School* which is the medium by which we train those who sense a calling to ministry, *Interfaith Bible Training School* is the core curriculum school for the entire university. Each student must meet the requirements of *Interfaith Bible Training School* either through evaluation of previous experience, training, or schooling before entrance into a Master or higher-level program.

### 3. Who can apply?

Anyone who is a believer and wishes to increase their knowledge of the Word of God. You must also be at least 17 years of age or older. (Some younger are admitted through proper permission from parents or guardians and evaluation by I.U.).

### 4. What do you offer through Interfaith University?

Interfaith University offers a full slate of courses as well as credentials including certificate, diploma, master, and doctorate levels. We also hold *free-to-student* public graduations which allow students to invite family and friends to see them march. If you are interested in a graduation ceremony near you, please contact the Administrative Offices. We also offer private graduation ceremonies at local churches or other public facilities (there is a minimal fee for the private ceremony).

### 5. What about personal attention?

Each student is appointed a *Personal Student Advisor* who will be responsible for answering questions, addressing student concerns, and transmitting direct information. Students will have access to a *Personal Student Advisor* by email, telephone, and online correspondence.

### 6. When do classes meet?

Interfaith University is primarily a correspondence school. However, we do have some local classes that meet to review work and encourage growth. These classes normally meet once a week for can meet once or twice monthly. Contact our administrative offices to inquire about classes in your area.

### 7. How much of my time will this take?

Learn at your own pace. While we recommend that you adopt the principle of diligence and faithfulness, we offer tremendous flexibility. Correspondence lessons are accessible and can also be paid for online (secured credit card payment). Most core curriculum lessons can be used as daily devotionals and completed in 3-7 days.

### 8. May I share my course with my spouse?

You may certainly share your courses with your spouse; but in order to obtain a grade, your spouse must have their own student account, complete their own courses, and take their own tests.

**9. How much is tuition?**

Tuition is \$2,500 per degree level. There are fees that pertain to the evaluation of applicants, books, private graduation ceremonies, degree certificates for every level that vary. (See stewardship and educational investment scale.) Scholarships are available. See Advisor for more information.

**10. What are some career opportunities that could possibly come about for a credentialed Christian?**

This would depend on who you are, where you look, and who you know. Many churches and ministries as well as Christian businesses are in need of ministers, teachers, deacons, administrators, photographers, musicians, technicians, telephone staff, counselors, youth workers, producers, engineers, drivers, managers, coordinators, cooks, lawyers, nurses, accountants, bookkeepers, department heads, singers, building contractors etc... It would seem that documented Christian training would greatly enhance your appeal. We encourage members of our alumni association to consider one another.

**11. Once I graduate then what?**

This would be answered best by having a strong sense of God’s direction for your life, which Interfaith University is designed to help you to gain. However, we do have an alumni association called *Micro-Church Central*. This association is made up of graduates, friends and partners. This will give you an opportunity to continue to fellowship with other students and to support ongoing school projects. We also expect that students will interact by inviting one another to attend and on occasion even speak at events that they are holding. The alumni association is a fellowship and continual Christian education medium.

**12. How does the online course registration process work?**

After enrolling at Interfaith University and receiving an acceptance letter, students are eligible to begin the registration process. Create a student account by logging into the Interfaith University student portal ([www.InterfaithU.net](http://www.InterfaithU.net)). Navigate to the “Posts” section and locate the DEGREES WE OFFER (Nomenclatures) posting. At the top of this page, there will be a link to register for the Mandatory Student Orientation. This will provide further guidance on course registration. Once orientation is completed, students should revisit the Degrees We Offer page to find the program he/she enrolled in for access to the program syllabus. Here the student may review their course requirements, learning objectives, required books, required paper etc. and register for their first course.

Ten minutes before the course ends, students will be given the opportunity to take the examination. Students should thoroughly study all information provided in the course before proceeding to the examination. Only click to take the exam when fully prepared. When testing, simply, follow instructions and submit the examination. Exams are graded immediately after they are taken. (See Grading System.) Then, return to the syllabus to register for the next course, following the same procedures. The final assignment for each program is the required paper. (See Required Papers for Earned Degrees.) A minimum of 30 days prior to graduation, after completing all program requirements (submitting all exams and the required paper, etc.) the student should inform the Administrative Offices of his/her intent to graduate.

**13. Are there any fellowship opportunities throughout the year that allows interaction between distant students?**

Certainly, we have women’s, men’s, youth, and family conferences annually. We also offer orientation seminars, Foundations of Faith Encounters, and graduation ceremonies. You may request an itinerary from your Advisor.



**14. May I hold an orientation session at my church?**

With proper permission from the church leadership we can arrange some on-site orientations to help facilitate awareness about the school and its' benefits.

**15. What about my required textbooks for my courses?**

Interfaith University now provides textbooks in the form of e-books that each student is required to purchase and download. Here are the steps to purchase and download e-books from the Interfaith University bookstore:

- 1) Navigate to the bookstore: Enter the Interfaith University website ([www.InterfaithU.net](http://www.InterfaithU.net)). Then click bookstore and browse through the e-book collection.
- 2) Once you have selected the e-book(s) you wish to purchase, click on the Add to Cart button next to each e-book.
- 3) Review your shopping cart to ensure that you have selected all the desired e-books.
- 4) Click on the Proceed to Checkout button to begin the checkout process.
- 5) Follow the prompts to complete the purchase.
- 6) After completing the purchase, you will receive an email with a download link for each e-book.
- 7) Click on the download link for the e-book you wish to view.
- 8) You will be prompted to download a reader software to view the e-book. Follow the instructions to download and install the reader.
- 9) Once the reader is installed, click on the download link again to open the e-book in the reader.

Please note that the download link may expire after a certain period, so be sure to download the e-book as soon as possible.

**16. Can I earn book discounts if I refer people?**

**17. What about missions trips and training?**

We are currently developing relationships with organizations that will allow our students to participate and even travel the world preaching and helping others if they desire to.

**18. What about robes, gowns, t-shirts and other school paraphernalia?**

You will receive current offerings of products and services in your monthly newsletter.

**19. Are there any extra curricula activities that I may participate in for academic credit?**

Yes, you may serve as a volunteer at any of our Interfaith University events. We often need ushers, greeters, camera personnel, audio technicians, prayer counselors, soul winners, musicians, singers etc... to ensure a successful conference or convention. Ask your Advisor for details.

**20. Can I start an Interfaith University class in my home or church?**

After you have met the requirements for the core curriculum class you may order an Interfaith University classroom in a box. This startup kit will include everything you need to understand advertisement, promotion, and development of an on-site class. Consult with your Advisor.

## **INTER-FELLOWSHIP AND COOPERATION**

We seek to cooperate with all local churches that stand upon the uncompromised Word of God and to work together with all other Christian organizations. We evaluate each student upon his or her personal qualities, not by past sins or former affiliations.

We wish to maintain a mutually respectful relationship with all other good Bible schools.

## **THE IDEAL BIBLE SCHOOL**

The ideal Bible course should meet three specifications:

1. It must be Biblically true, doctrinally sound, spiritually rich, very understandable, and useful in your daily life.
2. It should be inexpensive, affordable, and within the reach of most everyone.
3. It should not be too time consuming, too much of an inconvenience upon one’s busy schedule, and free from boring “busy work” requiring unnecessary toil and hassle.

The Holy Bible should be the Supreme Textbook of every Bible school and the steadfast criteria for judging all doctrines, practice, and experience. You will find at Interfaith University that each course is a well-organized body of knowledge about God, man, the Christian life and the ministry. They are spiritually inspiring and academically excellent, yet simply expressed and readable.

Each course is separated in a video lesson and/or book/booklet form. One should keep in mind that we are not selling paper, cover design or typeset. We are offering information to our students for personal and transferable edification. However, we do seek to apply the principle of excellence in all that we do. The book/booklet will contain basic information and several study verses that you must read and comprehend to answer the questions that follow. The questions are usually, but not limited to true or false, multiple choice and some essay or reading comprehension. These will stimulate your thinking and provoke analytical reasoning.

## **THE FUNCTION AND PROCESS OF EDUCATION**

The ability to *think* is the gift of the Creator, and the desire to *know* is divinely implanted.

Proverbs 9:10 says, “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom.” So, a proper recognition and respect for God is the *first* step of education. A wise man can render a reason for all he does, but a fool is smug in his thoughtlessness. A wise man will increase in wisdom, but a fool is closed-minded.

Education is a progression from knowledge, to understanding, to wisdom like the process from eating, to digestion, to physical energy.

Education is the important act of passing along the accumulated knowledge from preceding generations to the next one, without which we would be plunged back into the fears and superstitions of the dark ages of pre-history. Getting a degree just proves that you did your part in conveying the torch of truth to tomorrow’s youth.

Ideas rule the world of men, and new ideas have changed the course of history. Our generation has been dubbed “The Information Age.” But today’s scientific technology may be outdated tomorrow.

Therefore, the Church must rise to the occasion and meet the demands of a high-tech and rapidly changing society. Interfaith University views Christian education as a necessity and ministerial training- an absolute must!



The public knows of the need for training for the secular occupations, so why should anyone suppose that evangelists and pastors need no special training? An untrained person is usually considered an amateur. Ignorance is not stupidity; it’s merely a lack of information, so don’t let a lack of education hold you back. All other things being equal, a smarter Christian can do better than an ignorant one.

Christians need a good solid foundation upon which to build their faith and life:

1. Basic Biblical studies are for foundation.
2. Systematic Theological studies are for indoctrination.
3. Ministerial studies are for practical application.

Taking our courses not only involves the acquisition of Divine data, but the cultivation of mental discipline and promotion of spiritual growth. Our object is to not only spiritually illuminate men and women, but to motivate them in a life of usefulness for the glory of God.

In the Christian, natural and spiritual knowledge is integrated, as they both come from the same Source. The better our understanding, the better we can take advantage of our opportunities in life.

Our training courses will increase your effectiveness in any ministerial project you undertake. Some of our graduates are already teaching in local churches, and others go directly into the field of Christian Education. The best teachers teach because they love to teach, and the best students study because they love to learn.

We believe that the spiritual truths we learn on earth will be retained in our heavenly life and will be built upon for eternity. If you have dreams and aspirations, your personal Christian Education must not be postponed!



## **BIBLE COLLEGES**

A college is an educational institution that offers courses of study beyond the high school level.

There are over a thousand home study Bible Institutes in the U.S.A. today, and many are just offices that mail out Bible Courses to thousands of students. Sometimes major Bible schools change to become correspondence schools, while some correspondence schools start having local classes.

Spiraling costs are a common complaint, as a residential school can cost over \$20,000 per year, which is financially infeasible. When a school gets too expensive, time consuming, and strenuous its enrollment usually begins to shrink.

Like churches, there are different kinds of schools, so different types do emerge. We acknowledge many good schools around the world, but we know you will never regret your decision to complete your education with Interfaith University.



## **UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE**

Most people know that “freshman”, “sophomore”, “junior”, “senior”, and “graduates” are the ranks of students of higher education.

Community colleges offer undergraduate programs that lead to a Diploma, Associate, and Bachelor degrees. Universities offer graduate programs that lead to Master and Doctor degrees.

A university is usually bigger than a college and is often made up of several colleges on a single campus. If a college is not a subdivision of a university, it sometimes grows and becomes a university, so that today “College” and “University” are used somewhat interchangeably.

A religious school that offers Master and Doctor degrees is called a seminary. So seminaries are the universities of religious education. But, they can also offer undergraduate studies.





## **PROGRESSIVE LEVELS OF DEGREES**

A degree is an academic title conferred by an institution of higher learning showing that a person has satisfactorily completed a particular program of study. Degrees are progressive. One level is built on the preceding one, each level representing a higher work effort, and the equivalent of another year of study. A certificate is a document attesting a level of achievement in a course of study or training.

1. **TRAINING CERTIFICATE**- (40 credits) This is the first level and is like an Introductory Level Christian Worker’s Certificate.
2. **COMPLETION CERTIFICATE**- (usually 60-64 credits, but we require 90) This is the certificate awarded for the completion of a training program for Christian Workers. This is our Practical Ministry Module.
3. **DIPLOMA**- (170 credits) This is a certificate awarded by an educational establishment to show that someone has successfully completed a course of study.
4. **MASTER**- (250 credits) This represents at least one year of study beyond the Bachelor but, lower than the Doctorate, indicating that you have “mastered a subject.” Note: This degree program is eligible to those who have a Bachelor’s degree or those who through credit for life & ministry experience, you are guaranteed admission into our Master’s degree program. We also encourage you to go on to the Doctor’s degree program.
5. **DOCTOR**- (280 credits) This academic title is awarded for the completion of advanced study and is the highest degree there is. It is the ultimate in the educational world and has been a title of respect for learned persons since Biblical times (Luke 6:46). It is traditionally held that it takes a Doctor to confer a Doctor’s degree upon someone else.

Interfaith University requires its students to make at least a 70/C on examinations. It seems that most of our students earn good - excellent grades.

## **REQUIRED PAPERS FOR EARNED DEGREES**

Interfaith University does not require as much work of our students as Oxford or Cambridge, but we do require written papers for most of our credential levels. It takes skill to rally, arrange and polish your ideas. The paper that you write is to provide practice in clearly communicating your thoughts. It is a self-teaching method to develop your ability to express yourself in written form. If you have ever written anything you should be able to write a good paper for your degree.

First, understand your topic. What is it that you are going to write about? Of course your paper is to represent original, independent research, avoiding plagiarism (copying other's work without giving proper credit). We encourage creative thought--expressing your own knowledge, ideas and understanding.

Educators do not always agree, but there is not a lot of difference between:

1. **An Essay**- a brief personal literary composition on some subject. It is shorter and less formal than a thesis, but reflective, analytical and critical.
2. **A Treatise**- a formal systematic and elaborate literary composition, presenting some serious subject. It is longer and more exhaustive than an essay. A treatment of evidence, principles, and facts followed by a conclusion.
3. **A Thesis**- a formal essay or treatise on a particular subject presenting some proposition advanced and defended by argumentation. An exposition offered by a candidate for a degree- usually the Master's. A logical premise or postulation (as opposed to a hypothesis) such as the Thesis of Martin Luther that he nailed to the Church door, protesting Catholic corruptions.
4. **A Dissertation**- a formal lengthy treatise on some subject written as partial fulfillment for a degree, usually a Doctorate; an extended discourse or discussion written in an argument format and learned manner.

Interfaith University requires the Essay to be at least two full pages or more, the Treatise to be at least four full pages or more, the Thesis to be at least twelve full pages or more and the Dissertation to be twenty-four full pages or more. We encourage long papers. A regular sheet of typed paper typed double-spaced is about 250 words, so six pages would be about 1,500 words and twelve pages would be about 3,000 words.

- ✓ Use plain white paper 8 ½ x 11 only
- ✓ Type double space, as error free as possible
- ✓ One inch margin, on top, bottom, and both sides
- ✓ Number your pages at bottom
- ✓ Staple or bind it together



## **THE TOP COVER SHEET SHOULD CONTAIN:**

- STUDENT NAME, STUDENT #, STUDENT ADDRESS
  - The school name and address
  - The title of the paper
  - The degree that it is for
  - The date it is submitted

Although we encourage fresh work, if you have previously written, original materials, they may be submitted to your Advisor for credit consideration.

Most schools charge a fee for reading, evaluating, and grading a student's paper, and it does take considerable time, attention and concern. However, Interfaith University reserves the right to require a fee or not for this service.

Remember; never send your original paper, but rather a photocopy of it. We will keep your paper on file as part of your permanent record. Of course, we would never copyright your work, but we do reserve the right to use it for the Lord's work as we see fit.

## **PUBLIC GRADUATION CEREMONIES**

Interfaith University generally holds a conference and convention that includes a very vivid, formal, Public Graduation Ceremony annually in April and November. Interfaith University students from all over are welcome to participate in these exercises. These ceremonies are important as this is where we officially confer degrees upon those who have earned them. Public Graduation Ceremonies are free to graduates. Travel, room and board as well as food is at the expense of the graduate. To participate in graduations, students must have met their program requirements and should notify the school of their intent to graduate at least 30 days prior to the graduation ceremony. Contact the Administrative Offices for details about this year’s graduations.



## **PRIVATE GRADUATION CEREMONIES**

Students may arrange a Private Graduation Ceremony at their local Church or some other public facility. During these ceremonies graduates get to address the audience in a brief Official Sermon. Graduates will also have their credentials conferred upon them by Interfaith University faculty and staff in the midst of the people that they want to be there, since they will gather and invite the guests.

## **DEGREE DESCRIPTIONS**

### **TRAINING CERTIFICATE**

**Basic Bible Study Course-** This certificate is conferred upon students who have fulfilled the necessary requirements to complete their study of the Bible. The course work required for this degree includes courses ideal for any layperson seeking a greater knowledge of God's Holy Word.

**Biblical Studies-** This certificate is conferred upon students who have completed the necessary requirements to complete the course work dealing with the biblical origin of all things. The course work includes exciting and spiritually rich foundational courses that details the simplicity of God's Plan for Man. It is recommended for any person seeking a wealth of solid Bible foundation on this most important subject.

**Marriage Therapy-** This certificate is conferred upon students who have met the necessary requirements to an introductory study on the covenant of marriage detailing the elements of a successful family.

**Messianic Prophecies-** This certificate is conferred upon students who have fulfilled the necessary requirements to complete an introductory study on the prophecies found in the Old Testament that reveal the truth about the Jews coming Messiah as fulfilled in Christ. **Diploma of Messianic Prophecy-** This earned degree is conferred upon the student who has completed an exciting follow-up course that expounds upon the 333 prophecies of the Old Testament fulfilled in the life of Christ in the New Testament. This course is recommended for all believers who search for deeper knowledge of Jesus Christ as revealed in the Old Covenant.

It argues this defense based primarily from reason rather than revelation. The course work required for this degree contrasts Christianity with other religions while scientifically solidifying the genuineness and authenticity of faith in Jesus Christ and the Holy Bible. A thesis on this advanced subject is required at the completion of this study.

**Master of Christian Counseling-** This earned degree is conferred upon the student who has completed advanced level course work that builds upon the course work covered on the diploma level. Courses discuss effective, informative methods to counsel people from a Christian worldview. A thesis on this advanced subject is required at the completion of this study.

**Master of Christian Education-** This degree is conferred upon the student who has studied the fundamental and necessary components of teaching from a Christian worldview. Pedagogy, theory, and methodologies (including the teachings and teaching methods of Christ) are examined in this course. The course work for this degree also focuses on the development of Christian character. This degree is recommended for those persons interested in teaching the Bible in the church, school, or mission field. A thesis on this advanced subject is required at the completion of this study.

The course work required for this degree covers Biblical strategies for local, urban, and international missions; and describes many other aspects of evangelism. A dissertation on this advanced subject is required for this title.

**Doctor of Pastoral Counseling-** This earned degree is conferred upon the student at the completion of a thorough study and is the highest degree there is for Pastoral Counseling. Course work required for this earned degree specifically trains pastors in the areas of consultation, advisement, guiding, and admonishing people with the Word of God. A dissertation on this advanced subject is required for this title.

**Doctor of Sacred Scripture-** This earned degree is conferred upon the student at the completion of a thorough study and is the highest degree offered for this subject. This course work provides students and theologians alike with an invaluable resource on hermeneutical study, and post-modern Biblical research. It covers the powerful, authoritative, cleansing, and purifying effects of the Word of God. A dissertation on this advanced subject is required for this title.

**Doctor of Theology-** This earned degree is conferred upon the student at the completion of a thorough study and is the highest degree there is for Theology. The course work for this degree focuses on the relationship between God, the universe, and man. It also includes a cultivation of the theological virtues of faith, hope, and charity. A dissertation on this advanced subject is required for this title.

**Doctor of Christian Missions-** This degree is conferred upon the candidate who exemplifies character, integrity, and dedication in the area of missions, particularly cross- culturally.

**Doctor of Divinity-** This theological degree is conferred upon the candidate who has proven integrity, character, and dedication in the area of divinity.

**Doctor of Evangelism-** This degree is conferred upon the candidate who has proven integrity and dedication in fulfilling the Great Commission and proclamation of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

**Doctor of Humanity-** This degree is conferred upon the candidate who exemplifies integrity, dedication, and credibility in the area of the humanities.

**Doctor of Sacred Literature-** This degree is conferred upon the candidate who exemplifies character, integrity, and dedication in the area of sacred writings.

**Doctor of Sacred Music-** This degree is conferred upon the candidate who exemplifies integrity, dedication, and credibility in the ministry of Sacred Music.

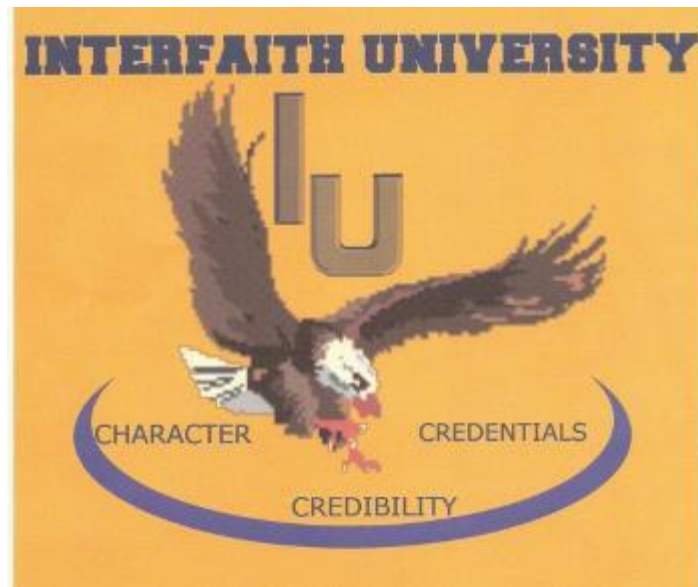
